

FAITH, CHARACTER, AND SERVICE

First and foremost, McCallie is a Christian school. That term can be defined in many ways, and we want you to know what that means for us. We don't hide from the fact that we're a Christian school and we hope you don't hide from your own faith background, even if you don't have one.

At McCallie, you will take multiple Bible and religion courses, giving you a stronger sense of **YOUR OWN SPIRITUALITY** while also growing your **UNDERSTANDING** and **COMPASSION** for others. You will attend chapel services featuring talks from faculty, seniors and outside speakers. We expect that you will listen to and **RESPECT EACH MESSAGE** you hear, but we never expect you to subscribe to a specific belief system. Additionally, boarding students attend a worship service of their choosing each weekend, whether it be our on-campus service led by the Student Vestry or an off-campus church or place of worship.

We believe that every boy who comes to McCallie should leave as a man ready to live **A LIFE OF HONOR**. That's why our Honor Code, which has been part of the school for more than a century, is so important. One of the first things you'll do as a McCallie student is sign your name in the **BOOK OF HONOR**, committing to abide by the Honor Code and its principles. Lying, cheating and stealing are not acceptable at McCallie, and honor violations like these are addressed by the Senate, a group of students elected by their follow students.

We also take service seriously. Instead of requiring you to do a certain number of community service hours, we think there's more value in helping you learn to make **SERVING OTHERS** a habit. Whether it's helping build our annual Habitat for Humanity house (20 years and counting!), taking a leadership role in one of the programs we run in nearby elementary schools to help younger students or being part of groups that focus on serving other students on campus, you'll find **YOUR WAY TO GIVE BACK**.

STUDENTS AT MCCALLIE AREN'T LIMITED TO WHAT'S BEEN DONE BEFORE. OUR STUDENTS CREATE THEIR OWN CLUBS AND SERVICE PROJECTS EVERY YEAR.

Some recent examples:

- Students led the creation of a creative writing outreach program in local elementary schools, providing tutoring and mentoring to young students.
- McCallie students created a
 Happiness Club, whose sole purpose
 is to bring a little joy to campus
 through small, thoughtful acts.
- After a McCallie alumnus lost his life to bone cancer, McCallie students joined with girls from our sister school, GPS, to create Mission:Remission, a walk to raise money and awareness of cancers that affect young people.



"McCallieisms"

Sometimes McCallie speaks a language all its own! Here's a helpful guide to the words you'll hear as you explore McCallie.

Duck Day: A day to "duck" out of school every spring to swim, play games, eat food [So. Much. Food.] and spend time as a community before the push to finish the school year.

Middle School 101: A class custom-built for 6th graders to make the transition to middle school smoother, giving them the tools to succeed at McCallie!

Fourth Meal: A meal served every weeknight at 9:30 p.m. in the dining hall, because you need fuel to study and a reason to take a break.

Blue Slip: As a noun, it's form you fill out to leave overnight as a boarding student; as a verb, it's the act of spending a night off campus - to stay with a day student's family, head home to see your own or go on one of many school-sponsored trips.

Candlelight: McCallie's annual Christmas music program, produced with our sister school, GPS. When you're in Candlelight, you're part of a decades-long tradition that's one of McCallie's most beloved.

Blue Crew: The cheerleading team made up of McCallie and GPS students who cheer on the Big Blue at sporting events.

Friday Shirt: Every Friday, you can leave the tie at home and wear a McCallie blue polo shirt for the day.

The SAC: The Sports and Activities Center, home to the student center (and its awesome game room), five basketball courts, a strength and conditioning room, climbing gym and more.

Nader: Not the politician (ask your parents), but the shorthand term for Tornado. Usage: "I'm Nader gang for life."

The Ridge: Short for Missionary Ridge, the home of McCallie and a historic Civil War battle site. It's also another name for our campus.

Blue Tornado: McCallie's mascot. Always singular, never plural. When we compete, we are all one school and one powerful force.

T-Term: A two-week period every February when the upper school breaks with the normal schedule, and boys choose a class where they dive deep into a topic of interest, from the history of Southern music to the intersections of science and the humanities.

The Senate: A group of McCallie students, elected by their peers, who are responsible for enforcing McCallie's Honor Code. One of the highest and most important offices a student can hold.

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
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

the CAVE

If video is your thing, then McCallie's CAVE is the place for you. The Center for Animation, Video and Entertainment is more than a studio, more than a theater and more than a classroom. It's a hub of creative energy where tomorrow's directors and producers brainstorm ideas and use the state-of-the-art equipment to make those ideas reality.

Filmmaking and video production classes meet in the CAVE, which is home to a bank of high-end computers for editing, as well as a professional color grading suite, a fully-featured studio with lighting grid and cyclorama wall and even a studio dedicated to audio recording and mixing. When your production is complete, you can watch it with your classmates in the theater with full 11.1 surround sound.

The CAVE is also home to the Scott Langley '68 Film Collection, which includes a huge array of classic films from many eras. The films are viewed as part of classes and are also available for viewing by students.





The **TED**

What happens when you combine the maker movement with a school that's Built for Boys? You get the TED: the Turner Engineering and Design Center. By combining modern technology in the Lebovitz Innovation Lab with traditional tools and machinery in McCallie's engineering lab, the TED provides a setting for boys to create anything their minds can imagine.

Home to eight 3-D printers, seven Virtual Reality platform sets, a laser cutter and more, the Innovation Lab hosts freestanding classes, as well as serving as a workspace for courses across multiple disciplines to apply the act of making and creating to their academic focus. Boys have built a full video game cabinet, competition robots and replicas of ancient battleships.

The TED also houses the Global Conferencing Center, a meeting space equipped with technology that enables live video conferencing around the globe.






